

Horsham District Council

Grant to Six Towns Community Partnerships – updated clarification
13 August 2009

Horsham District Council has agreed to provide grant funding for the continued operation of the existing five Community Partnerships of Billingshurst, Henfield, Pulborough, Steyning, Storrington and the community partnership work being undertaken in Southwater.

This funding is provided as follows:

1. £3,500 each year for two years (2009 and 2010)
2. The grant is provided for meeting running expenses and the costs of consultation (research), forming action plans and running action teams associated with the Partnerships maintaining their role of ‘action through community consultation’
3. Specific project costs are expected to be met through alternative funding sources as already organised by each partnership and AiRS.
4. Each partnership should ensure that Horsham District Council has the correct account details for payments to be made by BACS asap.

Payment:

5. HDC requires a 1 page A4 summary from each Partnership giving their outline action plan for the year ahead which will act as the justification for use of the grant as per item 2. Ray Lee at HDC will then sign off on each grant and pay each Partnership via BACS
